In Person Learning-

Elementary and Middle Schools- Cafeteria-Students will still have the opportunity to visit the cafeteria to pick up and eat their meals, however, they will enter and be released in appropriate waves to ensure proper social distancing. Students do not need to sign up.

High School- Hallway/Common Area – By setting up carts or stations in hallways and common areas, students will be able to pick up their meals safely and return to their designated area for eating. Students do not need to sign up.

Meals off or onto the bus - As students come off the bus, they will have the opportunity to simply pick up their meal(s) from a foodservice staff member and head straight to the classroom. If split service or half days, meals may also be offered to students as grab-and-go options as they get on the bus.

Take-Home Meals – As students continue distance learning, meal pick-up sites and/or bus drop-offs will continue. Students learning in person will be offered weekend meals to being home on Fridays.
